## STEP 4: 4000-LEVEL REQUIREMENT

12 POLS credits at the 4000-level including one Politics Capstone, POLS 4901-4910 3.0 series.

## STEP 5: TOTAL POLS CREDITS - 42

### Residency Requirements:

No more than 21 credits in Political Science taken outside the Faculty of Arts may be counted toward the Honours BA. Atkinson and Glendon Political Science courses in BOTH the Fall/Winter and Summer sessions are considered outside of the department and are outside of the Faculty of Arts.

**MINIMUM GPA:** 5.0 (C+)
